California Alpine Club Board of Directors Meeting Treasurer's Report July 20, 2014

Financial Activity Revenue from Operations

First quarter revenues 2014 are \$5K lower than Q1 2013 \$47K. This was due to events at Alpine \$1K and Echo Summit \$4K. Unrelated Business Income (UBI) for the first quarter was well within IRS limits.

Expenses

Expenses were higher by \$13K, entirely due to the insurance premiums, which were paid in Q1 2014 versus Q2 last year. Q1 is normal for payment.

Budgets

The FY 2014 budget has been completed and is shown in the Financial Reports for June 30. Revenue is budgeted at \$150K versus \$152K actual for FY 2013 (-\$2K). Operating expenses are \$106K versus \$116K last year (-\$10K). Improvements are budgeted \$82K versus \$51K last year (+\$31K). Cash is budgeted at \$386K versus \$420K last year (-\$34K).

Solvency

Cash and investments are healthy with a year end FY 2013 balance of \$420K, versus a prior year end FY 2012 balance of \$430K. The budget for FY 2014 is a reduction of \$34K.

CAC By-Laws Change Project Status at July 20 2014

Phase 1 (approved at April Meeting): Summary:

- Directors and Officers elected for two years (not one)
- Remove two signature requirement on Treasurer
- Membership Chair authorized to collect entrance fees (not Registrar)
- Added flexibility for President regarding setting meeting dates

Phase 2 (brought to July Meeting): Summary of revised Article II Section 2 (Membership Classes):

- Senior Member and Senior Joint Member(s) must have at least 12 months regular/joint membership before applying (Bev Leve).
- Child deleted because it adds no value since any child is eligible to come to a Club event (at child rates). (Ann Meneguzzi).
- Family deleted for simplification. Family Membership is the same as Regular (or Joint) (Stefan Berlinski).
- Student upper age range extended to 26 versus 22 (Suggested by many). Students may hold office. All students must complete two activities etc. Other terms of Student membership are moved to Resolution 11.
- Life and Joint Life no longer available to new members.
- Associate makes it clear that the right to offset daily membership dues in up to three events against the Entrance Fee is limited to twelve months from the first event. (Bev Leve)

Implementation of Phase 2 will be contingent upon BoD approval of Resolution 11. [we cannot implement Phase 2 immediately because related parts of the By-Laws must be changed simultaneously]

Phase 3 (planned for October Meeting)

- 1. Conforms language in by-laws with changes approved in Phase 2.
- 2. Removes detail about new member processes and places in Resolution 11.
- 3. Additional changes (as recommended by Carroll Pearson and others), such as:
 - a. Delete references to Reserve Funds
 - b. Delete overly prescriptive language on Dues Distribution and etc.

Implementation of Phase 3 will be contingent upon BoD approval of Resolution 11 therefore immediately upon membership approval of Phase 3 the President will call a special meeting of the BoD to approve Resolution 11 which will trigger all the changes and result in the new set of by-laws.

California Alpine Club Board of Directors Meeting Strategic Plan Status at July 20, 2014

Background – The Alpine Club has entered a new century with very different circumstances from the founding in 1913. While there is no specific problem with the club, we want to assure the viability of the club given diversity of interests and expectations of members.

Objective - Create a detailed action plan for year 2015 forward. Gather background data on club member interests, satisfaction, complaints and vision for the future.

Scope – What should we be doing more of, and doing better. What should we be deemphasizing?

Implementation – How will changes be accomplished?
