It is a large, comfortable, year-round mountain Lodge in the Sierra Nevada at an elevation of 7,365 feet. The Lodge commands a superb view of Lake Tahoe Basin and surrounding mountains. Forty thousand acres of rugged granite peaks and the alpine lakes of Desolation Valley Wilderness area are within easy walking distance for hikers, mountaineers, and fishermen. Echo Lake, a mile from our Lodge, is a delightful place in the summer for swimming, fishing, and boating. In winter, the area excels for ski touring and snowshoeing. Nearby well-known downhill ski areas include Heavenly Valley, Sierra at Tahoe, and Kirkwood.
