As always I wish you and yours the best of everything.

Late September was busy. Jan and I had just returned from Spain after completing the final stretch of the Camino de Santiago and receiving our Compostela certificates. On Monday, September 28 V-P Jay Gustafson and



I provided snacks and set up the hall for a special meeting at Alpine Lodge. The Bay Area District (BAD) of California State Parks chaired the meeting. They have been conducting a Change In Use (CIU) analysis for Easy Grade trail located at Mt. Tam. Additionally, staff from the Accessibility Division of California State Parks was present to provide information on ADA upgrades that will be made at the Sidney B. Cushing Memorial Amphitheater (Mt. Theatre). BAD district and Statewide Trail staff gathered input from interested members of the public on the CIU of Easy Grade trail and the ADA upgrades. There was about 25-30 in attendance. The two-hour discussion was congenial and ranged from the explanation of the process for doing the study to questions of safety with bicycles and walkers sharing the trail. There were few questions on the ADA upgrades.

The following Sunday, October 4th, the CAC was one of 35 Exhibitors in the Discover Mt. Tam event. Members Amy Pertschuk, Renee Lee and I joined 34 other groups on the lawn behind the Mill Valley Community Center. Each group was expected to explain their role on Mt. Tam. We were provided with a large table, tablecloth and chairs under individual tents. All of the groups were associated with Mt. Tam. I do not recall all but they include Muir Woods Association, Save the Redwoods, California State Parks, Marin Municipal Water District, Mountain Play, Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy, National Park Service, Golden Gate Parks National Conservancy, Marin County Parks, and many more. The event was organized so that stakeholders in use and health of the mountain could meet each other and the community all in one space. Because of the meeting, we have one family with children preparing to join the club. This was the first such event. I look forward to the club being invited again.

I wish you all a wonderful Thanksgiving.


